EQUINOX 41

We proudly announce the launch of Equinox 41, the last planned hardware release in the Equinox family after the EQ40 and EQ73 models. The EQ41 features the same concept and the same auto configure setup as the EQ73, but with single widget view and a 4-inch screen in place of the 7-inch screen and three widget view of the EQ73. However, the EQ41 can handle four graphical metadata levels, the same as the EQ73, making it superior to the EQ40 in that regard.

After announcing the new timer widget and shades widget, we are constantly working on developing new and undated widgets. At present there are twelve different widgets available on the new EQ41: Lighting, Video, Weather; Scenes, Climate, Security, Audio, Cameras, Home Theatre, Pool Spa, and the new Shades and Timer widgets.

INTERCONTINENTAL CITYSTARS HOTEL, CAIRO

Smart integration maximises hotel comfort

The luxurious Citystars Cairo Hotel is located in the midst of the fashionable New Cairo district. The hotel is next to the trendy Stars Centre shopping centre with an imposing 640 shops. The two top floors of the hotel, containing the suites and the penthouses, were fully renovated. Vantage provided the home automation infrastructure for the suites and penthouses as well as the interface to the room management system.

The hotel management rolled out a hotel management system to optimise the quality of the guest experience. In combination with the Vantage system, this enables automation of room amenities such as lighting and curtains and allows related relevant information to be passed on to the staff. The InterContinental Group chose the Vantage InFusion system on account of its performance and stability. The hotel management team were also enthusiastic about elegant style and high-quality finishing of the keypads.

In each of the 43 luxury suites there is a compact equipment compartment, concealed from the guests, that houses the necessary dimmers and relays. This keeps the cable lengths short,

and it allows maintenance staff to perform their tasks without blocking the corridor.

Home automation

The Vantage system integrates several smart home automation capabilities in each of the suites. For instance, the system controls the lighting and looks after opening and closing the curtains. It can also control the heating and cooling functions of the HVAC system. Hotel guests can operate the system using the keypads or their iPad, iPhone or BlackBerry. The desired mood – Night Light, TV Mood, Business Mood, All On, etc. – can be called up with a single touch on the keypad, iPad, iPhone or BlackBerry.

Integration with the room management system

Extensive integration of the Vantage InFusion system with the Micros Fidelio and Vingcard room management systems creates significant added value for hotel guests as well as staff. For instance, the keypads in each suite have a Do Not Disturb (DND) button. When this button is pressed, notification is automatically sent to the Fidelio system and the doorbell is disabled. The DND state is also shown on a status screen out-

side the room. The Make Up Room (MUR) button acts in a similar manner. It tells the Fidelio system whether or not the guest wishes to have the room cleaned.

Check-in and check-out

The check-in function ensures that the room conform to the standards set by the hotel for temperature, curtain opening and so on when the guest arrives. The check-out function is primarily oriented to optimising energy efficiency. For example, the lighting and air conditioning are automatically switched off and the curtains are closed when this function is activated.

Who's in the room?

A special Presence indicator on a panel outside the room shows whether or not someone is in the room. The system is also able to distinguish between guests and staff. Motion sensors that detect human presence are installed in the rooms, and the system keeps track of which key was last used – a guest key or a staff key – to determine who is currently present in the room.

Optimal integration with Fidelio and Vingcard creates unprecedented benefits

The remarkable Presence function is just one example of the enormous benefits arising from the strong collaboration between the Vantage system and the Fidelio and Vingcard systems. A Presence indicator on a status panel outside the room shows whether or not someone is in the room. The system also knows whether

a guest or a staff member is in the room. All this is made possible by sensitive motion sensors in the room that detect every human presence, and the fact that the system keeps track of which key was last used – a guest key or a staff key – to determine precisely who is currently in the room.



and penthouses can activate various scenarios. Some scenarios are intended for the guests, and others for the staff. For example, the Night Light function gradually dims the room lighting over a period of 30 seconds and switches on the night lighting. Another function is TV Mood, which switches on the television set and dims all lighting that could cause reflections on the television screen.

The Turn Down Task function is intended for the hotel staff. This hidden function, which is concealed to prevent accidental activation by guests, resets the Make Up Room function. The staff use this function after cleaning the room. When the guest returns to the room later on, it is immediately apparent that the room has been cleaned.

Energy

Energy consumption can be reduced by about 10% because the lighting circuits in the suites are connected to Vantage dimming modules. In addition, a pre-programmed timer raises the air conditioning temperature to 20°C between 2am and 4am, which allows the fan to run at the lowest possible speed. This gives the guests a better night's sleep and makes a significant contribution to higher energy efficiency.

The slim Equinox 73 with its full-glass LCD touchscreen (7" screen diagonal and three full widgets) uses presence detection and light sensors to automatically activate the desired custom mood and adapt to prevailing lighting conditions.

Equinox 73 users directly experience versatile system operation with a luxurious look and feel, including animations and twelve pre-programmed widgets. Navigation is child's play with simple touch and swipe operation. There are also two touch buttons: one for navigating to the start page and another that can be programmed by a certified Vantage integrator according to the customer's wishes.

Consistent mobile apps

The Equinox apps for tablets and smartphones running iOS or Android are effectively a mobile extension of the Equinox 73 touchscreen. These consistent apps have been specifically developed to have the same look and feel for the user as the GUI of the touchscreen.

Highly customised operation

The Equinox 73 and its mobile interfaces offer users numerous ways to radically simplify the control and operation of the system. Once the

screen has been configured by a Vantage integrator, end users can customise it to suit their wishes and can save the widget parameter settings using a simple on-screen interface to compile fully individual dashboard profiles. Any desired number of profiles can be created. Every dashboard can be retrieved using a simple drop-down menu. With a prescriptive template for fast programming and easy on-screen customisation, then Equinox 73 provides a unique user experience.

The touchscreen and the accompanying apps are initially being launched with nine pre-programmed widgets for controlling essential home automation functions: lighting, moods, weather, indoor temperature, multi-zone audio/video, home cinema, cameras and security. With the associated release of Design Center 3.2.0.4 (DC), Vantage's programming tool for integrators, data can be loaded automatically from the DC file into the widgets. This vastly simplifies interface programming for dealers, and it gives users a more consistent overview of all system functions.

The innovative design of Equinox was in part driven by specific feedback from our user base. We listened to what our customers had to say and developed a product that evolves with the needs of our users. Equinox is the archetype of intuitive, adaptable and easily programmed user interfaces.
